3. Introduction

3.1. Document Purpose

 This document has been published in accordance with Smart Energy Code (SEC) Section F5.1A. It defines the temporary rights and obligations of the Data Communications Company (DCC) and SEC Parties in the ordering and delivery of Communications Hubs for all Regions. The provisions of this document vary the businesses as usual rules that apply under SEC Section F (including in respect of the SEC definitions which are defined by reference to Section F5).

3.2. Scope

2. The Temporary Communications Hub Ordering and Delivery Rules (TCHODR) defines the variations from SEC for ordering requirements which apply to all Regions for all SEC Parties which may apply from time to time with SEC Panel approval.

3.3. Change Control

- 3. In accordance with SEC Section F5.1A, DCC shall only make changes to the TCHODR where it has:
 - a. undertaken reasonable consultation with SEC Parties regarding proposed changes;
 - b. given due consideration to, and taken into account, any consultation responses received; and
 - c. received approval from the SEC Panel to make such changes.
- 4. DCC shall publish an updated copy of the TCHODR on the DCC Website.

4. CSPC&S and CSPN orders for delivery months January 2023 onwards.

- 5. Each SEC Party's Communications Hub Orders for each Delivery Month starting from January 2023 shall be made in accordance with the requirements of this section.
- 6. Each SEC Party's submitted Communications Hub forecast volume, submitted to the DCC via the Order Management System, as of April 2022 for each delivery month from January 2023 up to and including March 2023 will be used for calculating allowable variance when Party's submit final Orders, in standard SEC timeframes.
- 7. Each SEC party's submitted Communications Hub forecast volume, submitted to the DCC via the Order Management System, 12 months in advance of the delivery month, will be used for calculating allowable variance when Party submit final Orders, in standard SEC timeframes.
- 8. For each Communications Hub Order submitted by a Party in respect of a Region that the aggregate (for all Consignments) of the Delivery Quantities of each HAN Variant for the Delivery Month must be:
- a) No less than 80% of the forecasted volume submitted in line with the above requirements
- b) No greater than 120% of the forecasted volume submitted in line with the above requirements
- 9. All other standard SEC requirements apply.
- 10. These conditions will cease to apply for delivery months October 2024 onwards.

4. CH Ordering in C&S Region

- 5. These rules will apply to CH forecasts and orders of 2/3G CH in the C&S Region only.
- 6. For Delivery Months of October 2025 to June 2026 replace F5.10 with the following.
- 7. F5.10 In order for a Communications Hub Order to be a compliant order, the order must comply with the requirements of this Section F5.10. A Party is not obliged to submit a compliant order, but a noncompliant order may be amended by the DCC in accordance with Section F5.17. The requirements of this Section F5.10 are, for each Communications Hub Order submitted by a Party in respect of a Region, that the aggregate (for all Consignments) of the Delivery Quantities of each HAN Variant for the Delivery Month must be:
- (a) greater than or equal to the higher of 80% of the number of Communications Hubs of that HAN Variant forecast for that Delivery Month and Region in the Communications Hub Forecast submitted by that Party in the 10th month prior to the start of the Delivery Month; and,
- (b) less than or equal to the lower of 120% of the number of Communications Hubs of that HAN Variant forecast for that Delivery Month and Region in the Communications Hub Forecast submitted by that Party in the 10th month prior to the start of the Delivery Month.
 - 8. Forecasts provided in September 2025 will set the thresholds for orders under F5.10 for deliveries for July, August and September 2026.

11.9. These rules will cease to apply for forecasts made in October 2025 onwards, where standard SEC rules will apply.
